
#### **History and Culture**

### **Sources of Nonprofit Revenue, 2010**

- Earned revenue (fees, charges): 50%
- Government: 32%
- Philanthropy: 13%
- Investment Income: 3%
- Other: 2%

#### Can Increased Private Giving Offset Federal Budget Cuts?

Federal Cuts in Nonprofit Program Areas -5% -10% -15%
